



Ada Huja history


Island of Ada Huja and surrounding areas are associated with founders of ancient Celtic town Singidunum, 300BC

In 1900's the area is abundant with vineyards, rich in biodiversity


It is the area with preferable wind conditions, and natural water springs. Ada Huja iz marked as IBA- Important bird area 120 bird species

In 1960', Ada Huja, becomes Belgrade's waste dump before it moves to Vinca.

In 2000 Ada Huja becomes illegal waste dump for constructional material, while river branch is the spot were all waste waters from surronding area.









Supernatural Park


In October 2011, Supernatural movement signed a contract with the municipality of Palilula to clear the illegal depot from the tip of Ada Huja and to establish an educational, cultural and environmental protection centre there, called Supernatural Park.

During the year 2012, this space, once inaccessible to public, is turned into an environmental park featuring; THE GREEN CLASROOM - designed for the purpose of educating the young people on the subject of environmental protection; GREENHOUSE - for the experimental cultivation and exhibition of plants and promotion of horticulture, 350 mg of natural gravel has been laid and walking lanes formed. For the purposes of revitalizing Supernatural Park 2 GARDENS of 1000m² each have been completed, covered with 500 mg of high quality humus layer with support from the public utility company JP Srbija Suma, Apatinska brewery, The Delegation of the European Union to the Republic of Serbia and embassies of respective countries: USA, Canada, Germany, France, Austria, Finland, Great Britain, Bulgaria and Belgium. With the assistance from the Serbian Ministry of Youth and Sports 100 seedlings of ash trees, one common oak and one sallow tree have been planted.

It was opened by the general secretary of Environmental Protection Department in the city of Belgrade, president of the Palilula municipality, chief of the department for international cooperation of the Republican ministry for the protection of waters. Supernatural Park project was presented on this occasion with the steps necessary for the revitalization of the Ada Huja ecosystem.

"Infostan" Recycling yard 18th April


At the space of 400m² in Supernatural Park a green area was formed with perennial seedlings of trees and especially designed containers intended for recycling of paper, metals, glass and plastics. Installation of Infostan Recycling Yard has offset a practice of collecting all the waste generated in and around the Supernatural Park area.
